Maricopa County presently faces a severe budget deficit problem. The Court Institution is committed to assist in reducing that deficit consistent with the duty to provide reasonable access to the courts and to provide due process thereafter.

For some years, the Superior Court has provided a convenient access to the court by use of a "traveling calendar" on a periodic basis to the Northwest (Glendale, and now Peoria) and to the Northeast (Scottsdale) portions of the county. The Clerk has likewise provided a convenience to residents of those areas for passports and marriage licenses.

Everything provided by the "traveling calendar" is available at the courthouses in Phoenix and at the Southeast Court Facility. Passport and marriage license services are likewise available at these locations.

As Presiding Judge of Maricopa County, the determination is made that, while these "traveling" services provide reasonably

convenient access to the courts, the present budget problems have a greater priority for the Court's attention than does convenience.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that, effective April 1, 1994, the "traveling calendar" of the Superior Court at Peoria and at Scottsdale is suspended until further order of this court.

ORDERED that, effective April 1, 1994, the "traveling" passport and marriage license services of the Clerk of the Court at Peoria and Scottsdale are suspended until further order of this court.
