A.R.S. 325-812 authorizes the Clerk of the Superior Court to sign orders establishing paternity of a child when the State or the parents file one of the following: (a) A birth certificate signed by the mother and father of a child born out of wedlock. (b) A notarized statement signed by both parents acknowledging paternity or separate substantially similar notarized statements acknowledging paternity. (c) An agreement by the parents to be bound by the results of genetic testing including any genetic test previously accepted by a court of competent jurisdiction, or any combination of genetic testing agreed upon by the parties, and an affidavit from a certified laboratory that the tested father has not been excluded.

The mother and father of a child born out of wedlock may request that the child's name be amended on the birth certificate at the time of acknowledging paternity. This Administrative Order specifically authorizes Special Commissioners to sign an order of voluntary acknowledgment of paternity pursuant to A.R.S. 325-812 and authorizing Vital Records to amend the child's name on the birth certificate.

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to A.R.S. 312-211 and 312-212, appointing the following persons as Special Commissioners for the limited purpose of considering and signing orders of voluntary acknowledgment of paternity pursuant to A.R.S. 325-812 and authorizing Vital Records to amend the child's name on the birth certificate.
